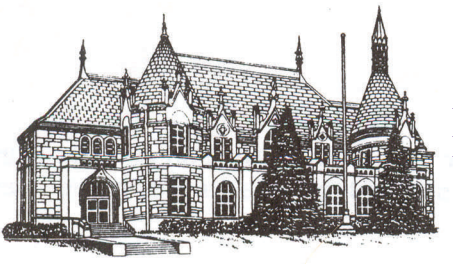

Grades: K-12

Visit the Castle Museum for a taste of local history. Built in 1898 by the federal government to serve as Saginaw's post office, the Castle is now home to a variety of exciting historical exhibits. No charge for teachers or chaperones.

Brady Hill Cemetery/City Hall Tour

Grades: 4-12

1 hour at each location

Students will have an interdisciplinary experience at Brady Hill Cemetery, where they will learn about famous people in Saginaw's history, and symbolism in art and architecture. Also, learn about Saginaw's style of government, how taxes and elections work, and what goes on in City Hall.

Grades: 4-12
